What is a 4-H CloverBud?

A CloverBud is a 4-H member in the Primary age category. Due to liability constraints, members younger than 8 years old are limited in

their direct engagements with horses, thus this program was created to integrate and educate young enthusiasts in different ways until they are 8 years old.

The 4-H Equine Project has many different paths for members with different interests. We have knowledge activities AND competitions, leadership opportunities inside and outside of your club, in addition to the 5 major disciplines of equine competition offered in our county: Performance (English and Western), Western Games, Driving, Hunter Over Fences (Jumping), Dressage (Traditional, Western and Driven), and several other competitive events as well.


