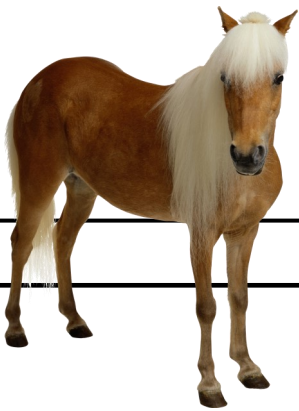

Welcome to the 4-H Equine CloverBud Passport !

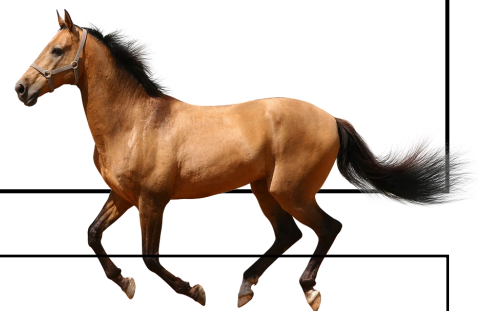
What is a 4-H CloverBud?

A CloverBud is a 4-H member in the Primary age category. Due to liability constraints, members younger than 8 years old are limited in their direct engagements with horses, thus this program was created to integrate and educate young enthusiasts in different ways until they are 8 years old.



The 4-H Equine Project has many different paths for members with different interests. We have knowledge activities AND competitions, leadership opportunities inside and outside of your club, in addition to the 5 major disciplines of equine competition offered in our county: Performance (English and Western), Western Games, Driving, Hunter Over Fences (Jumping), Dressage (Traditional, Western and Driven), and several other competitive events as well.

This passport is made to give the CloverBud and their adult helper an adventure map to explore the 4-H equine world before the pressures of competition begin as a Junior and encourage future exploration as the member journeys through 4-H.



As with any passport – you don't need to visit every country each year. Pick a few 4-H events and activities and enjoy the journey!
