For example, if there is a conflict between *Horse Smarts* and *Equine Science*, *Horse Smarts* would be considered correct as it is a newer publication.

All Washington State 4-H Horse Project Publications, as listed in the current EM2778 4-H Projects & Publications are potential sources for County and State contests. It is understood that these references/sources will NOT be used at National level contests.

All listed sources are used by both Horse Bowl and Hippology for State Contests! All listed sources except the WA State and PNW sources (marked with the is symbol) are used at National Contests by both Horse Bowl and Hippology.
