Day of entries will be accepted at the show by 12:00pm at \$10 per class/round.** Please submit a separate entry form for each horse & rider combination. Entries withdrawn due to illness or injury are accepted with Veterinarian's or Physician's notification. Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel classes. ALL CLASSES WILL BE SPLIT AND/OR JUDGED SEPERATELY BY AGE DIVISION.

Awards: High Point & Reserve High Point ribbon in all age groups, in all divisions. Winner's choice of award and blue ribbon to 1st place. Rosette ribbons to 8th place. No placings for Warm-up classes. Danish Ribbons to equitation classes only.

- NO: Walk/Trot, Novice Riders or GREEN Horses.
- Medal riders must qualify by receiving 3 Blue Danish Ribbons in Regular 2'6" Equitation Over Fences classes.
- No cross entry of horse & rider between cross pole, 2'0" and 2'6" divisions.
- All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved equestrian helmets *at all times when mounted*. Proper tack and equipment are required - please review the PNW Contest Guide and Snohomish County Reference Guide.
- At least one warm-up jump will be provided in the warm-up arena and accessible for HOF entered rider's use only prior to the start.
- **To compete in Hunter Over Fences at the Snohomish County (Evergreen) Fair, horse & rider must participate successfully in at least one Snohomish County Hunter Over Fences show at the level entered at Fair.**
